Our Body is the Temple of the Holy Spirit

- I. God dwells within His temple, Believers (Corinthians 6:19-20)
- II. Plan of Satan to defile temple: i.e. sexual intercourse outside of marriage, perverted sex, smoking addiction, alcohol addiction, etc. (1 Corinthians 3:16-17; John 10:10)
 - a. Example in deliverance spirit of abortion cast out of a Christian. 40-year-old man, curled up like fetus and screamed. His mother attempted to abort him.

Satan's Goal to Invade the Life/Body of Believers and Unbelievers

- I. Can a Christian have a demon? Correct terminology:
 - A. Nothing in original Greek to justify putting the word "possessed" alongside the word "demons". The correct translation is to have an unclean or evil spirit. (Matthew 11:18)
 - B. A Christian cannot be possessed by demons but can be under the influence of or have an evil spirit. (i.e. Ananias and Sapphira. Acts 5:3)
 - i. Supporting scripture: Proverbs 20:27; Proverbs 20:30
 An example is a person who had breathing problems. They manifested demons before they were healed.
- II. Satan is an intellect who wants to stop us from becoming a Christian or being an effective Christian. (Romans 6:6; Romans 6:11)
- III. Satan has descending orders of authority in the heavens. (Ephesians 6:12)

Jesus has Spoiled Satan's Authority

- I. Satan Has/Had Authority (John 12:31; 2 Corinthians 4:4; 1 John 5:19)
- II. Authority has been disarmed (Matthew 28:18; Colossians 2:15)
- III. Still poses a challenge, but doesn't have victory (Daniel 10:13)

The Strong Man (Matthew 12:29)

- 1. Spirits seen in the Life of Jezebel (1 Kings 16:29-33, 21:26)
 - a. False prophets, sexual immorality, idolatry (Isaiah 47:8-10,12; Revelation 2:20-21)
 Origin: Disobedience to the commandment not to worship idols. (Exodus 20:1-5; Deuteronomy 6:5)

Spirits operating:

- Double-mindedness (James 1:8)
- Schizophrenia
- Senility (Isaiah 47:6)
- Drug abuse
- Occult worship and witchcraft (Isaiah 47:9)
- Illicit sexual sins (Isaiah 47:8)

- Queen of kingdoms (Revelation 17:1-6, 15)

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- ii. Fruits of Jezebel:
 - Radical feminism (i.e. worship of Wicca)
 - Homosexuality

 - Strike her children dead
 - Divorce (Revelation 2:20)
- iii. Children of Jezebel Child's name "Terror"
 - Mother-child pattern: Semerimus/Tammuz (demonic Queen of Heaven), Venus/Dianna
- iv. Masculine examples: Astaroth and Nimrod.
- b. Ahab was weak-minded (1 Kings 21:4), was the tool of his wife, Jezebel (1 Kings 21:7&25).

Example in deliverance: 50-year-old woman raised her skirt like a child of 5 as the demon of rebellion manifested.

- c. Four downward steps:
 - i. Pride
 - ii. Rebellion
 - iii. Deception
 - iv. Perversion (Cut cords into heavenlies)

i.e. During a time of trauma, shock, anger, rejection etc., the spirit enters the child and from then on, the child will begin to exhibit these tendencies.

^{*}Note the spirit often lurks in the background, waiting to send its demonic power into a young child, either in the womb or after birth. The chain has often been established through the generations and the spirit is a familiar spirit, following the generations. But it awaits its chance to strike.

- III. Death and Hell (Revelation 20:13-14)
 - a. Spirits under this control:
 - i. Curses such as frequent accidents, succession of deaths in families.
 - Remember to reverse the curse, "Bless those who curse you, bless and curse not." (Matthew 5:44)
 - ii. Sickness, pain, plagues on Christians, breathing problems (i.e. Woman bound by spirit of infirmity Luke 13:11)
 - iii. Guilt
 - iv. Condemnation Results:

- IV. **Unholy Trinity:** Cast out Jezebel, then Antichrist, then Death and Hell. (Revelation 18:7&8, 19:20, 20:14)
- V. **Spirit of Control** (Matthew 16:23)
 - a. Many people have a controlling spirit which will deny the truth. The devil can bring peace as well as turmoil. Spirits of Control act to control the person and prevent deliverance.
 - b. The function of the control spirit is two-fold:
 - i. To shield the human spirit from hurt
 - ii. To bring calmness

This demon frequently comes in during childhood as a result of a trauma

i.e. Child's father says, "I am going away and will not come back." Child takes on the demon to ease the pain.

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Casting Out of Demons

Jesus always commissioned His disciples to both preach the gospel and cast out demons. (Matthew 10:1, 28:18-20; Luke 10)

Descriptions of Demons

- I. Demons are spirits without bodies.
- II. Demons have personalities:
 - a. They have a WILL (Matthew 12:44)
 - b. They have **EMOTIONS** (James 2:19)
 - c. They have **KNOWLEDGE** (Mark 1:23-24)
 - d. They have **SELF-AWARENE**SS (Mark 5:9)
 - i. Demons will name themselves (i.e.: anger, hate, envy, jealousy and fear) Example in deliverance: Praying for a woman with long-standing condition in her stomach. The demon said, "I won't go, this is my home, I will not leave her." Asked the demon its name. It said its name and then disappeared, and she was healed.
 - e. They have a **CONSCIENCE**, resulting in their fear to respond (1 Timothy 4:2)
 - f. They have an **ABILITY TO SPEAK** (Mark 1:24)
 Will frequently speak out of people as we are casting demons out. Sometimes voice is high-pitched and sometimes screams or gabbles.

How Demons Acts

- I. They **ENTICE** (James 1:14)
- II. They **DECEIVE** i.e. heresies. (Timothy 4:1&2)
- III. They ENSLAVE (Romans 8:15) i.e. compulsive talking, eating, addictions to alcohol, smoking, pornography/masturbation.
- IV. They TORMENT and OPPRESS (2 Timothy 1:7) Fear, condemnation, doubt.
 - a. Many people feel lighter when they have been delivered. They say, "Something heavy has left me."
- V. They **DRIVE** and **COMPEL** (Luke 8:29) i.e. lust, murder assault.
- VI. They **DEFILE** (Titus 1:15) i.e. rock festivals.
- VII. Their function is to **HARASS** (Acts 16:16-24)
 - a. They often work in groups, e.g. anger, fear, violence, defiling, rejection etc.

Demons Fight Against Our Peace

- I. Against our PERSONAL HARMONY
- II. Against our PEACE OF MIND
- III. Against our PHYSICAL WELL-BEING
- IV. They cause **DISRUPTIONS** with other people, especially those close to us. (i.e.: spirit of offense)

The Great Distinctive Mark Is Restlessness

^{*}Scripture references are from the New King James Version, unless noted otherwise.

Demons drive, compel, torment and harass. Fight against inner harmony and cause disruption in relationships.

- I. Gift of discerning of spirits (1 Corinthians 12:10)
 - a. Thought, vision unction/impression, or the audible voice from the Holy Spirit, given by God, which makes a us realize unGodly spiritual forces are affecting a person or even ourselves.

How They Operate

- I. From OUTSIDE the body
 - We must resist them (James 4:7)
- II. From WITHIN the body
 - We must expel them (Mark 1:39)

Areas in Which Demons Affect Us

- I. Soul (Mind, Will Emotions)
 - a. Emotions:
 - i. Attitudes: resentment, hatred, fear or rebellion.
 - Persistent, compulsive, bring fear
 - Moods that are unreasonable and extreme,
 - a. i.e.: become very talkative or quick shift in depression
 - ii. Psychologically:
 - i.e.: recurrent evil and disruptive emotional attitudes which dominate us against our will
 - iii. Relationships
 - iv. Gift of discerning of spirits (1 Corinthians 12:10)
 - b. Mind: doubt, unbelief, indecision, procrastination, compromise
 - c. Will:
 - i. Tongue: lying, cursing, gossip, blasphemy, mockery, unclean language
 - Psychiatrists claim people tell up to 200 lies a day without knowing it.
 Spirit of lying can rest on our tongue like a spirit of unclean talk and blasphemy.
 - ii. Persistent or violent opposition to the truth of Scripture and the work of the Holy Spirit.
 - iii. Unscriptural doctrine or prohibitions, unnatural asceticism, superstitions observances (i.e.: charms, fortune-telling, astrology, mediums)
- II. Body (Physical)
 - a. Sexually: perversion, same-sex attraction/homosexuality, masturbation, perversion of all kinds, uncontrollable unclean thoughts or looks,
 - b. Addictions: alcohol, nicotine, gluttony, anorexia food (root is often frustration).
 - c. Physical infirmities (Luke 13:12-13): tumors, heart attacks, cancer, arthritis, allergies, cramps, asthma, digestive issues
 - d. Unnatural restlessness and talkativeness

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*Note: One of the foregoing symptoms alone would not necessarily be conclusive indication of demon present, but where several symptoms are found together, the probability of demon activity is extremely high.

How Demons Enter

- I. Personal Sin: idolatry, rebellion, unforgiveness (Samuel 15:23; Romans 6:6; Galatians 5:16-21)
- II. Generational/Ancestral Sin: idolatry, racism/hatred, murder (Exodus 20:5)
 - Examples: Rejection, spirits of grief, spirit of memories
- III. Effect of hereditary bondages:
 - Domination of one person by another, i.e.: spirit of Jezebel
 - Mind thought life (fantasy)
 - Necromancing (Numbers 19:11) i.e.: witchcraft, the occult
 - Trauma/Shock (particularly at times of accident)
 - Grief depression
 - Accidents
 - Marriage breakdowns
 - Sexual Habits, i.e.: masturbation, smoking, bestiality
 - Soul ties
- IV. Transference: (Environment)
 - Moving with people who are not Christians
 - Movies, television, music, magazines
 - Substance abuse (alcohol and drugs)
 - Transference of spirits in a church
 - Scattered souls (Proverbs 6:27)
 - Sexual intercourse, child molestation
 - Satanically inspired music and dancing
 - Entry of witchcraft through feet and womb
 - Unforgiveness (Matthew 18:34-35)
 - Rejection:
 - Conception
 - Mother's womb
 - Baby not bonded: adopted child
 - Hereditary rejection
 - Practices in the family home: males vs. females
 - Peers
 - Self-rejection
 - Spirits of tradition: pride and prejudice and religion
 - Encumbrances of tradition
 - Doctrinal obsessions
 - Legalism
 - Personal prejudices
 - Familiar spirits affecting families
 - Occult (Deuteronomy 18:9-12)

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 Influences of witchcraft: Abnormal fears, especially in the dark, disturbing dreams, hatred of being left alone, spirits of Antichrist.

Example in deliverance: Woman healed from bleeding - spirit exited out her ear-went to fortune teller at age of 10

- V. Results of involvement in the Occult:
 - Depression: melancholia to suicidal thoughts
 - Resistance to the Word of God:
 - apathy/lack desire for prayer and Bible study
 - no word of prayer coming to one's lips
 - blasphemous thoughts against God and Christ
 - religious delusions
 - Visions of ghostly forms or visions of people in past generations
 - Fear & Anxiety: gripping feeling around the throat
 - Manic fits, fits of rage
 - Inability to make decisions
 - Voices you cannot rid; no matter how much you fight
 - Schizophrenia
- VI. Additional Entry of the Demonic
 - Ethnic traditions, culture and environment: i.e.: Japanese ancestor worship, religious spirits
 - False Religions & Heresies (teachings which deny John 10:9 and 1 Timothy 4:1-2)
 - Jehovah's Witnesses
 - Mormons
 - Freemasonry
 - Curses:
 - Self-imposed
 - Relational
 - Witchcraft/Witchdoctors
 - Unscriptural covenants.

Example in deliverance: A man who saw father try to strangle his mother when he was 5. Hated his father. Was told for years later, "You are just like your father." This became a spirit.

- Watching people die, especially after nursing them
- Fire-walking, i.e.: Fiji and India
- Charms and fetishes in our homes. (Deuteronomy 7:25-26)
- Yoga and martial arts Kung Fu, Aikido, Tae Kwon Do, Karate, Tai Chi, Judo (rooted in Taoism and Buddhism)
- Transcendental Meditation, Extra Sensory Perception, Hypnosis
- Piercing the flesh (Leviticus 19:28, 21:5; Deuteronomy 14:1; 1 Kings 18:28; Mark 5:5)

To Be Delivered We Must

- I. Humble ourselves and complet honesty in turning from all pride, rebellion, deception and perversion
- II. Confess our sins (James 5:14-16)

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- Examples of healings in meetings where people have confessed their sins
- III. Repent
- IV. Forgive
- V. Call on the Name of the Lord (Acts 2:21)

Manifestations

- Hissing (tongue goes in and out like a snake's tongue)
- Spitting
- Wriggling
- Sighing
- coughing and gasping (smoking demons)
- shouting
- lying down as though dead (spirit of coma, hypnosis)

- mucus (demons of sexual uncleanness white foam)
- animal noises
- yawning
- sobbing
- roaring (hate demons)
- screaming
- eyes roll back and flutter only white part visible - or operate independently

- nostrils flare
- lips purse
- foul smelling fluids
- twisting figures (often masturbation)
- blood from mouth
- smell like sulfur
- Sometimes nothing

Example of manifestation: Acts 8:7

Why People Are Not Delivered

- I. Unrepentance
 - *Note difference between repentance and remorse. (Matthew 27:3)
 - a. Unrepentant of their sins: esp. pride, adultery and abortion. (James 5:6)
 - *Note: Four downward steps: pride, rebellion, deception, perversion
- II. Unforgiveness (Mark 11:25-26)
- III. Failure to break with the occult (Acts 19:19)
- IV. Failure to submit to God and resist the devil (James 4:7)

Counselling

- I. Listen:
 - a. What does the person say about their problem?
 - b. Holy Spirit gives guidance
- II. Work with others
- III. Take rest periods during deliverance
- IV. The agent of deliverance is Holy Spirit

The Actual Deliverance:

- I. Establish faith in Jesus Christ alone (call on the name of Jesus)
- II. Total forgiveness required
 - a. Honor and forgive parents
- III. Renounce: any curses, idolatry and false religions, sins of ancestors

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- a. Remove charms or demonic jewelry
- b. Cleanse house from idols, carvings, etc.
- IV. Confess: sin and unbelief (ungodly beliefs)
- V. Confess/Plea the blood of Christ
 - Redemption and Forgiveness through Jesus' blood (Ephesians 1:7)
 - Jesus' blood cleanses ALL sin (1 John 1:7)
 - Justification through Jesus' blood (Romans 5:9)
 - Christ's Suffering/Blood brings Sanctification (Hebrews 13:12)
- VI. Physical Manifestations of Deliverance:
 - heavy breathing
 - coughing
 - Gas
 - Screaming
- VII. Praise God (many times)
- VIII. Additional Notes:
 - a. Sometimes fasting is required
 - b. Use prayer cloth (1 Chronicles 13:14)

The Minister

- I. Remember authority in Jesus Christ & fix your mind on Jesus Christ (Matthew 28:18)
 - a. absolute belief in the power of the Word of God and use the Word of God. (1 Corinthians 6:9
- II. Know the anointing of Holy Spirit The agent of deliverance is Holy Spirit
 - a. Ask for manifested gifts of discernment of spirits, wisdom, and words of knowledge
 - b. Use your prayer language (should be baptized in the Holy Spirit)
- III. Minister in Groups: plea the blood of Jesus before commencing in deliverance ministry
 - a. Remember to work with others, allowing them to bring forward any words of discernment or knowledge
- IV. Listen to what Holy Spirit is saying as to how you should pray
 - a. Ask/Command the person (demonic) to look at you and tell demons to go
 - b. Limit the prayer candidate's use the name of Jesus or speak in tongues while deliverance is taking place. Encourage them to receive. Caution against the counterfeit
 - c. Find master of demon/strongman and cast out
 - d. Agree and bind and loose the spirit (Matthew 18:18-19)
 - e. Be persistent and by the word of knowledge follow through the network of demons to the principal strongman
 - i. Cut ungodly soul-ties, cords of Jezebel, Antichrist, Death and Hell and any other spiritual powers
 - ii. Be aware of the children of Jezebel, e.g. child of Terror
 - f. Anoint with oil and consecrate various parts of the body (Romans 12:1-2)
 - i. Pour water on the person's forehead as a reminder of their baptism and cutting off from the power of sin
 - g. Laying on of hands
 - i. Ministering angels surround us (Hebrews 1:14)

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How to Maintain our Freedom

- I. Remain totally yielded to Jesus Christ in every area of life, make Him Lord of every area
 - a. Die daily to old self and reassert position daily in Jesus Christ
 - i. Person must assert will and resist devil (1 John 4:4)
 - b. Be always filled with Holy Spirit (Ephesians 5:18)
 - c. Believe and live by the Word of God (Matthew 4:4)
 - i. Put on the full armor of God (Ephesians 6:14-18)
- II. Be in God's Community (Ekklasia) Hebrews 10:25
 - a. Stay with the right people and receive ongoing counsel from pastor
 - b. Have the right relationships with people
- III. Deliverance is progressive (Possess the land)
 - a. Read the Word
 - b. Confess their sins
 - c. Come into true repentance
 - d. Baptized with the Holy Spirit. (Exodus 23:28-33)

Binding Demons When the Person is Not Present

(Matthew 18:18-20) Example of person in prayer meeting causing difficulty. Parents who have prayed for children who have disappeared - not heard from for a long time. Bound demon power affecting those children, prayed in belief and been full reconciliation.

Self-Deliverance (James 4:7)

Heavy oppression, suffocation, pain or sickness

- * Acts 19:19: "Also, many of those who had practiced magic brought their books together and burned them in the sight of all. And they counted up the value of them, and it totaled fifty thousand pieces of silver."
- * Deuteronomy 7:25-26: "You shall burn the carved images of their gods with fire; you shall not covet the silver or gold that is on them, nor take it for yourselves, lest you be snared by it; for it is an abomination to the Lord your God. Nor shall you bring an abomination into your house, lest you be doomed to destruction like it; but you shall utterly detest it and utterly abhor it, for it is an accursed thing."

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
